Title: NBCSN Liaison

Purpose: The NBCSN State Liaison Program purpose is to promote NBCSN Certification on the state level.

Responsibilities/Role of the State Liaison

As stated in the ASNA Bylaws – The NBCSN Liaison shall:

1. Serve as a resource on certification at the state level
2. Promote certification at the state level
3. Participate in state activities with NBCSN information
4. Serve as a liaison between state and NBCSN Board of Directors

Other Duties/Means of Promoting Certification

- Submit articles to State Newsletter about NBCSN
- Have displays with NBCSN information at state level meetings
- Have a liaison seat on State School Nurse Association Board (ASNA)
- Develop state level activities to obtain exam questions and then submit them to NBCSN - see Call for Questions at <http://www.nbcns.com/questions.htm>
- Formulate study groups for nurses that are going to sit for exam
- The annual report must be submitted by April 15th
